- understand that membership does not imply endorsement of products, services, practices or statements of the company and its employees or agents
- nominate a company representative, to manage the interface with IETA and ensure optimum feedback for the member company
- pay the annual membership fee, as currently determined by the Council
- accept the rules and regulations of the Association as they currently exist and as they may hereafter be altered

3. A reference and due diligence check will be conducted by the IETA Secretariat. Once complete, the final application will be reviewed by the IETA Board of Directors. Any further information that IETA may require will be requested.
4. You will receive a membership dues invoice as per the details supplied on the online IETA Application. **NOTE:** membership does not officially start until the membership dues are received.
5. Once the invoice has been paid, IETA will supply you with further information on membership, including access to working groups and codes to access IETA's member section on the website.
